MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE HOUSING SCHEME
FOR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ON OWNERSHIP BASIS
AT ISLAMABAD.

The second meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Governors for the Housing Scheme for Federal Government Employees on ownership basis in Islamabad was held in the Works Division on the 28th May, 1989.

4. The items on the agenda were :-

- a. Review of progress so far made in respect of decisions taken in the last meeting;
- b. Consideration of the eligibility of various categories of applicants;
- c. Establishment of a Housing Cell, allotment against the discretionary quota of the Executive Committee and case by case consideration of the requests received for the relaxation of rules/terms and conditions already prescribed for selection.

5. After detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken :-

- a. The applicants from whom declarations regarding possession of plots at Islamabad have not so far been received, may be given further time upto 8th June, 1989 to submit the same. Final notices are to be sent through registered post acknowledgement due/special messengers.
- b. The allotment letters category wise should be issued en bloc instead of in piecemeal.
- c. Deposits received from the applicants may be refunded on request.
- d. Deposits received from the applicants considered ineligible or in Priority II may be refunded forthwith.
- e. The following categories of applicants may also be considered for eligibility in allotment of different categories of houses :-
 - i) Ex-employees of the defence services who have been absorbed on regular basis and whose names are included in the gradation lists.
 - ii) Federal employees re-employed after the age of superannuation on the same terms and conditions as of the regular employees and in service on 1.9.88.
 - iii) Employees joining federal services after serving provincial governments and having total service of 20 years or more, with atleast 10 years service in the federal Govt.
 - iv) Civilian employees serving in the offices of Controller of Military Accounts, Survey of Pakistan, Military Lands and Cantonments (Civilian employees of the GHQ or MES are not to be considered).
- f. The previous decision regarding ineligibility of Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation employees including those transferred from Radio Pakistan at the time of formation of the corporation was un-held.

- g. Unsuccessful applicants in categories III and IV be given option to get houses of categories V and VI respectively. The final selection will be subject to the age-wise seniority as applicable to all categories. This was considered because of poor response of applicants in these two categories.
